Biography and Statement of Intent



Anastasios Panagiotelis is an Associate Professor and Deputy Head of Business Analytics at the University of Sydney Business School. He has served as a Director of the International Institute of Forecasters since 2021, where his responsibilities included leading the assessment of competitive grants and travel awards. He also acted as Program chair for the 2021 International Symposium of Forecasting, and as a member of the Scientific committee of the 2019 International Symposium of Forecasting. He has been an Associate Editor of the International Journal of Forecasting since 2023 and co-edited a recently published special section on forecast reconciliation.

His research lies in the intersection of business analytics, statistics and econometrics with a particular focus on forecasting. He has published in a diverse range of top-tier journals including the Journal of the American Statistical Association, Journal of Econometrics and the European Journal of Operational Research, and he publishes regularly in the International Journal of Forecasting. He led the project “Macroeconomic Forecasting in a Big Data World”, funded by the Australian Research Council. His work has spanned a diverse range of application areas, including macroeconomics, energy, retail, and demography.

Anastasios received his PhD from the University of Sydney and was previously a member of Faculty at Monash University and an Alexander von Humboldt Postdoctoral Researcher in the Faculty of Mathematics at the Technical University of Munich.
